

Parramatta Light Rail Stage 1



Parramatta Light Rail is one of the NSW Government's latest major infrastructure projects being delivered to serve a growing Sydney.

What do I need to know?

Parramatta Light Rail Stage 1 will connect customers from Westmead to Carlingford via the Parramatta CBD and Camellia.

Key destinations include the Westmead Health Precinct, CommBank Stadium, Riverside Theatres, the largest museum in NSW Powerhouse Parramatta, the Church Street dining and entertainment precinct, Parramatta Square and PHIVE, Rosehill Gardens Racecourse and three Western Sydney University campuses.

The Parramatta Light Rail will bring major benefits to businesses, local residents, commuters and visitors, supporting the development of Parramatta as Sydney's second CBD with 16 stops along a 12-kilometre route. This vital infrastructure will provide a catalyst for further investment in the area.

Parramatta Light Rail passenger services are expected to commence in 2024.

Key features

- High-frequency 'turn-up-and-go' services 7 days a week, departing approximately every 7.5 minutes in peak periods
- Modern and comfortable air-conditioned vehicles, 45-metres long, driver-operated and integrated with the NSW Opal card electronic ticketing system
- Shared light rail and pedestrian zones on Church and Macquarie streets in the Parramatta CBD

- A new shared walking and bike-riding path, also known as the Active Transport Link, between Carlingford and Parramatta
- NSW's first state-of-the-art green track, providing urban cooling and greener place-making, among other benefits.

What is happening during construction?

Activities, campaigns and events continue to be delivered to attract people into the Parramatta CBD and across the alignment during light rail construction and in the lead up to operations.

Transport for NSW also continues working with local businesses, residents and community groups to provide information and support during construction. Ongoing community engagement includes email updates, social media, pop-up information sessions and events.

An estimated **130,000** people will live within walking distance of the Parramatta Light Rail stops.
