


Permanent traffic conditions – North Parramatta

Parramatta Light Rail Stage 1

March 2024





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

To support public safety and the effective operation on Parramatta Light Rail, current traffic conditions in North Parramatta will remain in place.

Parramatta Light Rail is one of the NSW Government's latest major transport infrastructure projects being delivered to serve a growing Sydney.

In July 2020, Transport for NSW implemented temporary traffic changes on Church Street to support the construction of Parramatta Light Rail.

Transport for NSW has since reviewed traffic and operational requirements to improve safety and operational efficiency of Parramatta Light Rail.

As a result, Transport for NSW is making these current traffic movements permanent to support the safe and efficient operation of light rail services and the local road network.

Parramatta Light Rail Stage 1 will connect Westmead to Carlingford via the Parramatta CBD and Camellia. It is expected to open in mid-2024.

Traffic movements on Church Street

The following traffic movement restrictions will remain in place:

- No right turn from Church Street (travelling southbound) into Factory Street westbound.
- No right turn from Church Street (travelling northbound) into Pennant Hills Road eastbound.
- No right turn from Church Street (travelling southbound) into Grose Street westbound.
- No right turn from Victoria Road (travelling westbound) into Church Street northbound.

When and where we will be working

There will be some minor civil works over the coming months to support these changes, which may include concrete works, line marking, signage installation, intersection works and reconfiguration of the traffic lights. Transport for NSW will keep you updated in advance of these works taking place.

What does this mean for you?

Transport for NSW acknowledges that these right turn restrictions may have added additional travel time for some residents and motorists. Motorists are encouraged to use O'Connell Street, which has been widened to two traffic lanes in each direction as part of the project, and to only use Church Street between North Parramatta and the Parramatta CBD for local

access.

There are no changes or impacts to existing local driveway access, emergency services access, cyclist or pedestrian access, waste collection services or loading zones. Please use the contact us section if you have any questions or concerns.
