

Permanent traffic conditions – Parramatta CBD

Parramatta Light Rail Stage 1

March 2024



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

To support public safety and the effective operation of Parramatta Light Rail, current traffic conditions in the Parramatta CBD will remain in place.

Parramatta Light Rail is one of the NSW Government's latest major transport infrastructure projects being delivered to serve a growing Sydney.

Traffic conditions on Macquarie Street in the Parramatta CBD will remain in place to support public safety and effective light rail operations.

Since 2020, Transport for NSW implemented various temporary traffic changes on Macquarie Street to support the construction of Parramatta Light Rail.

Transport for NSW has since reviewed traffic and operational requirements to improve safety and operational efficiency of Parramatta Light Rail.

As a result, Transport for NSW is making these current traffic movements permanent to support the safe and efficient operation of light rail services and the local road network.

Parramatta Light Rail Stage 1 will connect Westmead to Carlingford via the Parramatta CBD and Camellia. It is expected to open in mid-2024.

Traffic movements on Macquarie Street

The following traffic movement restrictions will remain in place:

- No right turn from Macquarie Street (travelling eastbound) into Charles Street southbound.
- No right turn from Charles Street (travelling northbound) into Macquarie Street eastbound.

When and where we will be working

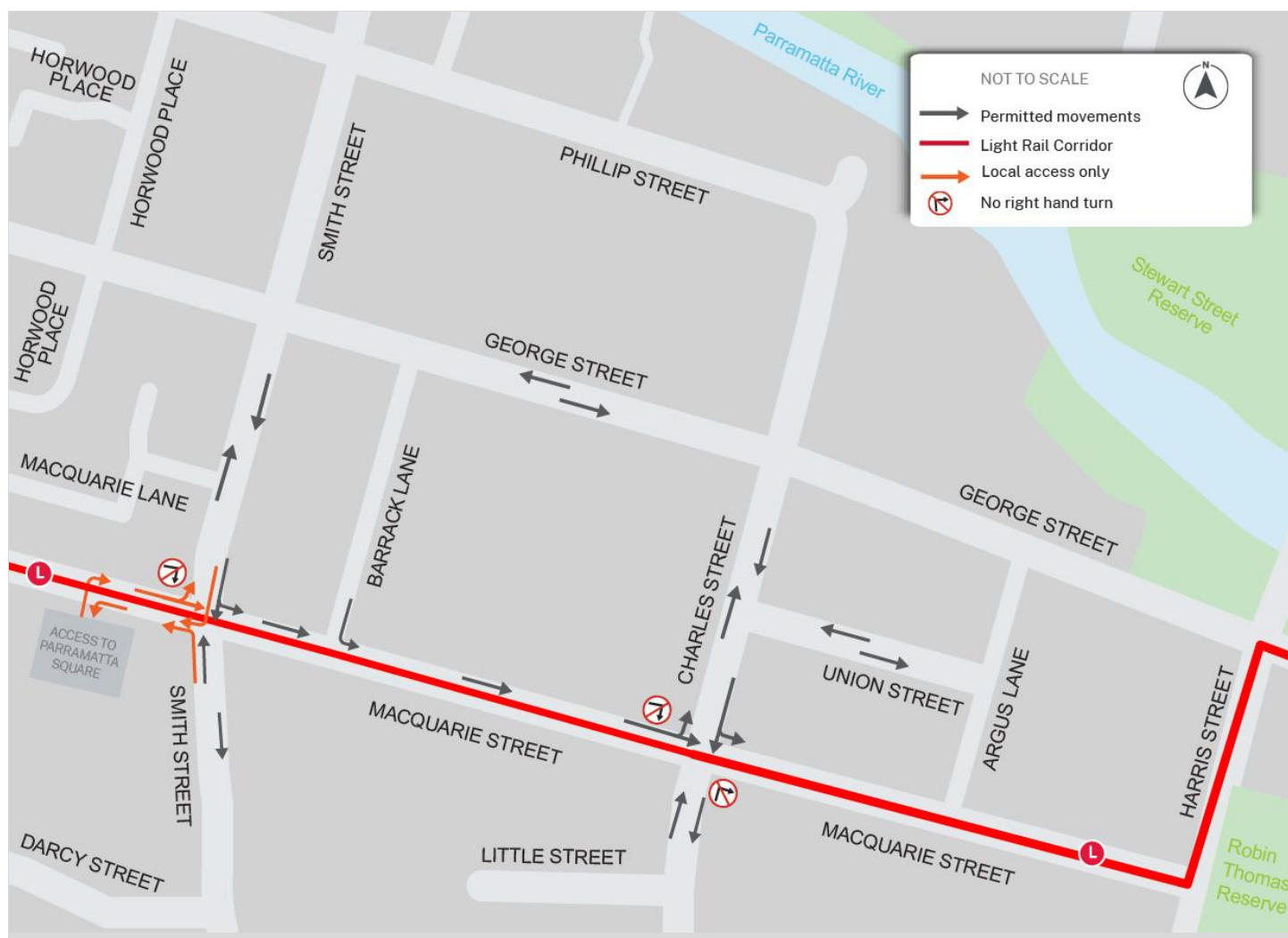
There may be some minor civil works over the coming months to support these changes, including concrete works, line marking, signage installation, intersection works and reconfiguration of the traffic lights. Transport for NSW will keep you updated in advance of these works taking place.

What does this mean for you?

Transport for NSW acknowledges that these right turn restrictions may have added additional travel time for some residents and motorists.
